Room Types & Prices

Rates are inclusive of all taxes and are on a room only basis. Breakfast is available on Campus and guests may avail of this service at an additional cost. Continental and Full Irish Breakfast service are available in the Buttery Food Court from 7.30am to 9.30am Monday to Saturday and 8.00am to 10.00am on Sunday. Continental Breakfast is also available in the Hamilton Restaurant during the same hours.

All rooms have access to a kitchenette suitable for light catering only, e.g. tea/coffee and toast. All bathrooms contain showers – there are no baths in college rooms. There is a no smoking policy in all college accommodation.

Discounts are available for children under 14 years of age. A limited number of cots (for babies up to 18 months/two years of age approx.) are available free of charge. Please request cots in advance. Rollaway beds are available upon request.

Payment & Cancellation Policy

We take the cost of the first night's accommodation at time of booking as a deposit. We accept MasterCard, Visa, Visa Debit cards, cash in Euro, Euro cheques can also be accepted, once drawn on an Irish Bank account.

If a reservation is not taken up by 10am after the first night's accommodation, or is cancelled less than 72 hours prior to check-in time, the reservation is void and a cancellation charge equal to the cost of the first night's accommodation will be made. A full refund will be given for bookings cancelled up to 72 hours prior to arrival. No refunds will be made for no-shows or early check-outs.

Payment of any outstanding balance is taken in full at check-in.

Arrival & Departure

The Accommodation Office is open throughout the week from 8am to midnight. Check-in time is from 2pm. Guests who have not checked-in before midnight may collect their keys from College Security at the Front Gate.

Guests arriving early will be offered a voucher to store luggage at no cost in the Trinity Conference Centre luggage room. Guests may use this facility at any time, however a charge will apply for this facility. On the day of departure, all rooms must be vacated by **10am** and all keys returned to the Accommodation Office or the College Security desk at Front Gate.

Getting Here

Trinity College is at the very heart of Dublin city centre so it is relatively simple to locate.

From the airport, a taxi will typically take about 20-30 minutes and cost around €30. Alternatively, the AirCoach (http://www.aircoach.ie/) typically takes about 30 minutes and costs €7 one-way or €12 return. Trinity College is less than 15 minute walk from the central bus station, Bus Áras. Vehicle access to College is via the Lincoln Gate. Please note there is a one-way anticlockwise system of traffic around Trinity College. Taxis may enter College via Lincoln Gate.

Pedestrian access to College is via Front Gate or Nassau Street Gate, (at the Trinity Conference Centre).
